Snooker right on cue for street kids

KIDS who have nothing to do but hang around on street corners are to be given a break free fun snooker sessions.

The scheme is the brainchild of Accrington-based North Lancs Training, which has become an official partner of the Paul Hunter Foundation.

It is being spearheaded by the group's e2e manager, Chris Lovell, who is one of only 25 world snooker grade A coaches.

He said: "The aim is simple – to get kids off the streets. Every time you turn on your TV these days you read about horrific crimes involving young people.

"We can make a difference to young people's lives by offering free fun-based snooker sessions on a regular basis."

The series of Paul Hunter roadshows will take place at the Cuemasters Snooker Club in Church on Thursday evenings from 6pm to 8pm, starting next week.

They are open to youngsters aged from eight to 18 who are fairly new to snooker, with the underprivileged and disabled being particularly welcome.

The emphasis will be on fun rather than long games, with the new concepts of 15-minute snooker and Nintendo snooker, a 60-second challenge, trick shot tuition and some professional coaching by Chris and fellow grade A coach Paul Rinaldi.





